



Preface

The 16-th issue of *International Journal of Theology, Philosophy and Science* (May 2025) presents scientific and theoretical articles on various aspects, all of them centred on the area of Philosophy, Theology, and Science.

In the first article is *EINSTEIN'S SUGGESTION OF A CONNECTION BETWEEN SCIENTIFIC PRACTICE AND ONTOLOGY. A NEW METAPHYSICS*, signed by Ph.D. Professor Antonino DRAGO. *Einstein's reflection of 1954 about the notion of "space" is substantially equivalent to a reflection about the notion of "set". In addition, this Einstein's writing suggests that the notion of space in theoretical physics enjoys a couple of distinctions in its meaning (one distinction explicitly stated by Einstein, another suggested in a somewhat covert way); and, owing to the above parallelism, also the notion of set-in mathematics enjoys a couple of two distinctions in its meaning.*

The next article is called: *MUSICAL SETTING CREATION FOR A YEATS POEM: AN AUTOETHNOGRAPHY WITH THE PROPELLER MODEL APPROACH*. Ph.D. Kevin M. STEVENSON, in these researchers and artist alike have their own unique challenges when it comes to engaging with their craft for the purposes of producing a final product. Both occupations hold their own respective identities when it comes to the labour of their work whilst holding other cultural and linguistic identities. The next study, by Valentina-Monica BARBA, has title *THE MALE-FEMALE RELATIONSHIP VIEWED THROUGH THE BOOK OF GENESIS IN LIDIA VIANU'S 21ST-CENTURY PROSE POETRY*. *The paper exemplifies the persistence of the biblical mandate given by God to Adam's Eve in the Book of Genesis (3:16) right to the 21st century. The discussion is based on the novel and three prose poetry books written by Lidia Vianu in the third decade of the 21st century.*

Ph.D. Professor Leontin POPESCU proposes our readers' two articles dedicated to interdisciplinary subject: *THE HOLY MYSTERIES EVENTS OF THE CHURCH AS THE MYSTICAL BODY OF CHRIST*. *The Church is a mystery that is difficult for human reason to fathom because of the mystical element that defines it as the Mystical Body of Christ. The presence of the mystical element entails a profound reality which reveals much more than what human reason can visibly, historically or socially perceive.* *THE TRIADOCENTRIC DIMENSION (PROPERTY/QUALITY) OF THE ORTHODOX THEOLOGY*, is the scientific research presented by Ph.D. Professor Adrian D. COVAN. *Conjugating the Godhead person communion life ensemble, the Church is an icon of Trinitarian relations, continuing the salvation opera of Its founder, Jesus Christ, essence and finality of personal relation between God and man.* The next study, by Professor Ph.D. George Daniel PETROV, present *THE CONCEPT OF TRINITY IN THE MYSTICISM OF ECKHART'S PHILOSOPHY AND IN ORTHODOX THEOLOGY*. *Philosophy has often sought to speak of God, attempting to express of the knowledge of His transitory being through reason only.*

Professor Ph.D. Michael Yurievich KUZNETSOV, propose the last article of our Journal, entitled: *RELIGION OF MAN-GOD BY L. FEUERBACH BY BULGAKOV*. *This study examines Sergei Nikolaevich Bulgakov's perspectives on Vladimir Solovyov's concept of Sophia and Ludwig Feuerbach's epistemology, as well as Bulgakov's political views on monarchy, constitutional monarchy, liberal republic, and the workers' state.*
